Luke 1:75 - In holiness and righteousness before Him all the days of our life.

- a. Christ is our holiness and righteousness.
 - b. Through trust in Christ, we have eternal life that we may be with God and serve Him forever.

- b. To give knowledge (Lk 1:77)
