General Identity & A Specific Identity

Why do we often have such a hard time living out of that general and unique identity that God has given us?

Stronghold = a mindset, value system, or thought process that hinders your growth.

Strongholds are almost always born from our doubts of God's goodness or His ability.

John 8:44 ESV – You are of your father the devil, and your will is to do your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks out of his own character, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Four ways that strongholds form and keep you from what is NEXT:

1) Words and Wounds

You can't spiritual bypass sorrow and pain. You can't go around it - you must go through it.

Jesus may live in your heart but grandpa is in your bones.

It is not noble for you to hate yourself. You are not what happened to you.

2) Comparison/Coveting

Comparison robs you of gratitude. And if you don't have gratitude, you don't have joy.

3) Perfectionism

If you are a perfectionist, your life will be ruled by fear.

4) Past Failures

How are we to fight & destroy these strongholds?

1)Repent

"Please forgive me Father."

2) Renounce

Formally declaring one's abandonment of.

3) Fight With Truth

Romans 8:1 ESV – There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus.
