2 Timothy 1:3-11 CSB – I thank God, whom I serve with a clear conscience as my ancestors did, when I constantly remember you in my prayers night and day. 4 Remembering your tears, I long to see you so that I may be filled with joy. 5 I recall your sincere faith that first lived in your grandmother Lois and in your mother Eunice and now, I am convinced, is in you also. 6 Therefore, I remind you to rekindle the gift of God that is in you through the laying on of my hands. 7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but one of power, love, and sound judgment. 8 So don't be ashamed of the testimony about our Lord, or of me his prisoner. Instead, share in suffering for the gospel, relying on the power of God. 9 He has saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began. 10 This has now been made evident through the appearing of our Savior Christ Jesus, who has abolished death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel. 11 For this gospel I was appointed a herald, apostle, and teacher,

## Familial Heritage & Christian Heritage

None of us come to faith on our own. None of us start faith and none of us end faith. BUT you and I are the continuum in between.

Discipleship is more personal than it is pragmatic. Discipleship is more relational than it is tactical.

May we live a legacy and leave a life behind that preaches the gospel.

### 1) We must come to see that we don't start the faith; we continue the faith.

How do we do that?

Hebrews 12:1 CSB – Therefore, since we also have such a large cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us lay aside every hindrance and the sin that so easily ensnares us. Let us run with endurance the race that lies before us,

Timothy: you must own the faith that your grandmother and mother had!

We must fan into flame the gift we have been given.

### 2) We don't invent the truth; we tell the truth.

Psalms 23:5 NKJV – You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.

While the meal annoys the enemy, the anointing TERRIFIES your enemy.

Isaiah 10:27 NKJV – It shall come to pass in that day That his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

Gift-giving: An inherent ability to do something well.

Anointing: A divine enablement to do something beyond natural ability.

### 3) We must see the anointing of the Holy Spirit as essential.

Luke 3:22 NKJV – And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased."

Luke 4:1 NKJV – Then Jesus, being filled with the Holy Spirit, returned from the Jordan and was led by the Spirit into the wilderness,

Luke 4:14 NKJV | Luke 4:17-18 NKJV

If Jesus, the Son of God, needed to be anointed by the Holy Spirit for His work, what makes us think we don't need to be anointed for ours?

How do you know you don't see the anointing of the Holy Spirit as essential? You rarely ask for it.

### 4) We must know the anointing of the Holy Spirit is for specific use.

God doesn't give more of His Spirit just because; there is always a specific because.

When the Holy Spirit gives you His anointing, it's because God has already given you an assignment.

### 5) We must know the anointing of the Holy Spirit comes with His power.

Your weakness is a divine setup for the God of the universe to flex His strength through you.

### 6) Don't ever let the anointing become more important than the Anointer.

"If You aren't with me, I can't be me."
