The Pain of Family // The Possibility of Family

God's heart is that spiritual life and blessing will flow down generational lines.

1) Break off some ungodly things from your past. 2) Build some godly things for your future.

Things We Need to Break Off:

1) Spiritual complacency.

Deuteronomy 6:10-12 NIV – When the Lord your God brings you into the land he swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, to give you—a land with large, flourishing cities you did not build, 11 houses filled with all kinds of good things you did not provide, wells you did not dig, and vineyards and olive groves you did not plant—then when you eat and are satisfied, 12 be careful that you do not forget the Lord, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

Physical prosperity can numb us into spiritual apathy. | We can't allow our blessings to rob us of hunger.

Judges 2:10 NIV – After that whole generation had been gathered to their ancestors, another generation grew up who knew neither the Lord nor what he had done for Israel.

2) Worldliness.

Deuteronomy 6:13-15 NIV – Fear the Lord your God, serve him only and take your oaths in his name. 14 Do not follow other gods, the gods of the peoples around you; 15 for the Lord your God, who is among you, is a jealous God and his anger will burn against you, and he will destroy you from the face of the land. To be a friend of the world makes me an enemy of God.

With children, there is what you 'want' to pass on, and 'what' you pass on.

If you are going to build an altar that the next generation can worship at and meet God at, you have to get rid of worldliness in seed form in your life.

Things We Need To Build:

1) A Compelling Vision of God

Deuteronomy 6:4 NIV - Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one.

Nobody else in history holds the tension of truth and love like Jesus Christ.

We want our kids to see the best of the church!

2) An Ecosystem of Discipleship

Deuteronomy 6:6-9 NIV – These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. 7 Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. 8 Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. 9 Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

We have a responsibility to take the beauty of Jesus and make Him come alive in their hearts!

3) A Vision of Spiritual Legacy

The reason Christians have no long-term institutional influence in our cities is because we have yielded it to other groups with longer vision.

How long is your vision for what it is that God wants to do?
