

Dwelling Place Church Vision: Manifesting Christ in Many Ways to Many People

#### Genesis 2:19-25 NIV

All of us need to broaden our understanding of what it means to be sexual beings.

Spirituality: can be described as a vast longing that drives us beyond ourselves in an attempt to connect with, to probe, and to understand our world. Beyond that, it is the inner compulsion to connect with the Eternal Other that is God. Essentially, it is a longing to know and be known by God (on physical, emotional, psychological, and spiritual levels).

Sexuality: can be described as the deep desire and longing that drives us beyond ourselves in an attempt to connect with, to understand, that which is other than ourselves. Essentially, it is a longing to know and be known by other people (on physical, emotional, psychological, and spiritual levels). – Deb Hirsch

We have a lack of discipleship as it relates to sexual wholeness.

1) The Starvation Diet – this diet is marked by repression and suppression. There is no space to talk about our longing and deep desires and connections to others.

2) The Fast Food Diet – this diet is marked by reduction. We think all of our longings should be fulfilled in any way we desire them to be fulfilled. There is no discernment with this diet. We are driven by our passions and longings.

Sexual wholeness is the prayerful integration of our spirituality and sexuality resulting in deep, satisfying relationships with others that roots out shame, cultivates vulnerability, and leads to healthy bonding. – Hirsch

To be made in the image of God means we were made for intimacy and bonds of connection.

Naked and Unashamed = these words describe their relationship to God and to one another.

### Some Theological Truths Around Sexuality:

1) Sexuality is a part of God's good creation.

### 2) There is a distinction between Genital Sexuality and Social Sexuality.

God establishes a means of covenant love; the family unit is marked by a covenantal sign of genital union.

Sexual intimacy is such a powerful force that it requires a context that is strong enough to protect it, and that is marriage.

### 3) Shame is a force we must regularly contend with.

Shame is a response in our brain and body that leads us to turn away from others while internalizing messages about how fundamentally wrong we are as persons.

What does it mean for us to be a community that is committed to sexual health & wholeness (free from sexual baggage)?

A recognition that we are all sexually broken.

The Bible is not a collection of sanitized stories of holy people. The Bible is a collection of ordinary, broken people who are loved by God and are made holy by a righteousness outside of themselves.

Sexual wholeness is not moral perfection.

Sexual wholeness requires the act of discerning who I give my body to.

Jude 1:7 NIV – In a similar way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding towns gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion. They serve as an example of those who suffer the punishment of eternal fire.

There is a massive effort to redefine and reclassify homosexuality.

1 Corinthians 6:9-11 NIV

Everyone is on a list. Fornicators, Idolaters, Adulterers, Homosexuals.

These sins top the list because they represent a moral divide. All sins are equal in their spiritual consequence, but not all sin is equal in its moral equivalence.

There is no passage in the OT or NT that supports homosexual behavior (Gen 19, Lev 18, 20, Judges 19, Romans 1, 1 Cor 6, 1 Tim 1). It was not until the mid-20th century did a church leader or Jewish leader affirm homosexuality. Every regulation in the Bible concerning marital relations assumes male-female sex. Every wise saying (Proverbs) assumes male-female sexuality. The Ten Commandments assume heterosexuality.

Sexual wholeness means we relate to others in ways not given to objectification.

Sexual wholeness is oriented around seeing God as the source and end of all my longings.

The Gospel is to make us more sexual, not less. – Hirsch

The Gospel offers good news to those carrying shame.
