

Hebrews 2:11-18 - For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren, 12 saying: "I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You." 13 And again: "I will put My trust in Him." And again: "Here am I and the children whom God has given Me." 14 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, 15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. 16 For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham. 17 Therefore, in all things He had to be made like His brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. 18 For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted.

INTRODUCTION

- We are children of God given to Jesus for His kingdom purpose.
- We are sanctified in spirit. He who sanctified us in spirit is working to completely sanctify our soul and body.
- Jesus is not ashamed to confess you as one with Him.
- He is an understanding, merciful and faithful High Priest in things pertaining to God for your life.
- "sing praise to You" = sing a hymn, to sing/ singing of paschal hymns. These were Psalms 113 - 118 and 136, which the Jews called the "great Hallel"
- A core value of Dwelling Place Movement is – Maintaining Focus on the Finished Work of Jesus Christ.
- God has revealed His redemptive nature to us in seven redemptive names.
- These seven redemptive names provide the primary needs we all have for life and godliness.

I. Righteousness (Jeremiah 23:6)

- a. Jesus took the penalty for our wrongs to make us right with God.
- b. Jesus died for your sins to give you the right to have a relationship with God.
- c. Jesus died for your sins to give you the right to access the only door to God's home.

II. Peace (Judges 6:23-24)

- a. Isaiah 53:5 – But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.
- b. Ephesians 2:14 – For He Himself is our peace, who has made both one, and has broken down the middle wall of separation,

III. Healer (Exodus 15:26)

- a. Psalm 103:3 - Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases
- b. Matthew 9:5
- c. Salvation is forgiveness of sins, righteousness and peace but it is not only that. Salvation refers to all that Jesus purchased for us through His finished work; which includes healing for the body and soul.

IV. Victor (Ex 17:5)

- a. He already won. The victory is purchased for you by the blood of His cross.
- b. Colossians 2:13-15
- c. It is not necessary for you to mentally understand how God had Jesus take your sins, your conflict stressors, your sickness, diseases, addictions and bondages on the cross – you are only called on to believe it.

CONCLUSION

- Proverbs 18:10 – The name of the Lord is a strong tower; The righteous run to it and are safe, secure, set on high.
- We run to His name. Gatherings are to be us running to His name; gathering in His name.
- This is why I will be willing to be inconvenienced.
- This is why I am willing to be welcoming.
- This is why I am willing to be inviting.
- This is why I am willing to serve.
- This is why I am willing to give God the sacrifice of praise; the fruit of my lips when we gather in His name.
