2 Timothy 4:6 - For I am already being poured out as a drink offering, and the time of my departure is at hand. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing.

### I. Introduction

- a. Paul's awareness
- b. Paul is conscious to the reality he has finished his race. Paul is what Scripture refers to as an overcomer.
- c. Paul imparted what he imparted and multiplied what he multiplied because he was an overcomer.

#### II. Goals

- a. If you want to be encouraged to overcome, then follow and glean from those who overcome.
- b. What do you do when you don't have any overcomers to follow? (2 Tim 4:15-18)
- c. Paul was able to overcome and able finish his course because first, he was clear on the goal.

#### III. Aim

- 2 Corinthians 5:9 Therefore we make it our aim, whether present or absent, to be well pleasing to Him. 10 For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.
  - a. Paul was able to overcome and able to finish his course because first, he was clear on the goal.
  - b. Paul was able to overcome and able to finish his course because second, he took aim at the goal.
  - c. When you take aim at the goal then:
    - i. You know when to fight and what to fight
    - ii. You have a motivation creator ((Phil 3:12-16)

#### IV. Wise Master Builder

- a. Paul the wise master builder (1 Cor 3:10)
- b. Wise building requires the end in mind. Paul as an apostle had received grace to know the goal of God and was then able to build with that end in mind as a wise master builder.
- c. Where I have not received God's wisdom I am unable to master.
- d. Seasons of life expose where I have not received God's grace and wisdom to know the goal and take clear aim.
- e. God has grace and wisdom for that gap, but pride & complacency must be strongly rejected.
- f. Jesus has overcome all things. Will you turn to Him. Will you ask for His help, His wisdom, and the work of the Holy Spirit?
