

1) What is so dangerous about the insecure you?

#1 – The insecure you always misleads you.

Insecurity will always lead you in the opposite direction God wants you to go.

Exodus 2:11-12 NLT – Many years later, when Moses had grown up, he went out to visit his own people, the Hebrews, and he saw how hard they were forced to work. During his visit, he saw an Egyptian beating one of his fellow Hebrews. 12 After looking in all directions to make sure no one was watching, Moses killed the Egyptian and hid the body in the sand.

Insecurity loves to overcompensate and underreact.

#2 – The insecure you always doubts you.

Exodus 3:9-11 NLT

Satan loves insecurity because when we are insecure, we are more focused on ourselves than on God.

#3 – The insecure you incessantly “what if’s” you.

Exodus 4:1 NLT – But Moses protested again, “What if they won’t believe me or listen to me? What if they say, ‘The Lord never appeared to you?’”

The tone in insecurity’s voice is always fear.

#4 – The insecure you cannot clearly see you.

Exodus 4:10 NLT – But Moses pleaded with the Lord, “O Lord, I’m not very good with words. I never have been, and I’m not now, even though you have spoken to me. I get tongue-tied, and my words get tangled.”

The insecure you creates narratives about you which God would never speak over you.

Acts 7:22 NLT – Moses was taught all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and he was powerful in both speech and action.

Insecurity causes you to magnify your weaknesses and minimize your strengths.

#5 – The insecure you always sees the last resort as only you.

Exodus 4:13 NLT – But Moses again pleaded, “Lord, please! Send anyone else.”

Satan loves to make God’s favorite weapons go wobbly.

2) How do you overcome insecurity?

#1 – Get a revelation of the power of a pure partnership between God and you.

Exodus 4:11-12 NLT | Insecurity is a guarantee when my security is in me. Confidence is guaranteed when my security is in God.

God will allow you to rely on you simply to teach you this won’t work unless you rely on Him.

God gives us weakness so we will come to the One who HAS all strength FOR our strength.

#2 – Get a revelation of God’s divine obsession with you.

Understanding God’s love for me was the beginning of me getting comfortable with me.

Psalms 139:13-17 NLT | Insecurity always involves a fear of the disapproval of or rejection of others.

Man’s opinion of me must be crowded out by God’s obsession with me.

#3 – Have a zero-tolerance policy for comparison.

Anyone you compare yourself to, you are competing against.

Satan loves to tear us down by getting us to compare up.

Comparison creates a striving that will often lead us outside the will of God.

Insecurity comes when you don’t understand: the power of God in you, the possibilities of God working through you, the magnitude of God’s obsession with you, and the divine uniqueness of the call of God on you.
