#### What got us here will not get us there.

Maximum leverage point – in the area of ministry and leadership.

What kind of leadership do we need to be a missional church?

The book of Ephesians = the constitutional book of the church. | Ephesians 4:1-16 NIV

vv. 1-6 – The Unity of the Church vv. 7-11 – APEST (Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Shepherds, Teachers) vv. 12-16 – Maturity/The Church Jesus Intended Us To Be

> APE – Generative Form of Christianity. ST – Operative Form of Christianity.

These are the gifts of Jesus. Jesus, Himself, gave certain gifts to humanity.

Ephesians 4:8 NKJV – Therefore He says: "When He ascended on high, He led captivity captive, And gave gifts to men."

Ephesians 4:11-12 NKJV – And He Himself gave some to be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, and some pastors and teachers, 12 for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the [a]edifying of the body of Christ,

As a believer, I do the work of ministry. But as a pastor, I equip you to do the work of the ministry.

Let's talk about apostles today – first, there are more than 12.

Luke 9:1-2 NKJV – Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. 2 He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.

Apostello - to be sent with a message.

Luke 9:10 NKJV – And the apostles, when they had returned, told Him all that they had done. Then He took them and went aside privately into a deserted place belonging to the city called Bethsaida.

Luke 10:1 NKJV – After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go.

Is there a process between being called and being sent?

The temptation between the call and the send is to produce the call in the flesh.

Romans 1:1 NKJV – Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God

Acts 9:15 NKJV – But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel.

Acts 9:26-28 NKJV – And when Saul had come to Jerusalem, he tried to join the disciples; but they were all afraid of him, and did not believe that he was a disciple. 27 But Barnabas took him and brought him to the apostles. And he declared to them how he had seen the Lord on the road, and that He had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus. 28 So he was with them at Jerusalem, coming in and going out.
