Romans 12:2 - "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God."

1. In making more disciples (numerical growth) the Holy Spirit reminds us through leading Jesus to the woman at the well that He is aware and compassionate of every individual's growth journey, including the minorities. (Jn 4:1-7)
2. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit challenges cultural patterns.
3. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit often blows and provides the gift of God outside of our human patterns of expectation. (Jn 4:10)
4. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit has different methods. (Jn 4:11-15)
5. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit is to connect everything in creation back to the substance in Christ.
6. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit confronts the patterns of sin, failure and dysfunction in our life. (Jn 4:16-19)
7. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit matures our understanding of true worship. (Jn 4:20-24)
8. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit causes us to leave behind our old patterns of living. (Jn. 4:28)
9. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit continues to mature existing disciples as they serve. (Jn 4:31-38)
10. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit confronts existing disciples' speech and its effect on their sight. (Jn 4:35)
11. The pattern of the wind of God's Spirit is to affirm kingdom sowing and reaping. (Jn 4:35-38)
