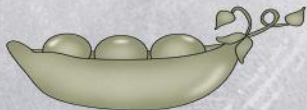

Daniel 6:1-3 - It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom one hundred and twenty satraps, to be over the whole kingdom; 2 and over these, three governors, of whom Daniel was one, that the satraps might give account to them, so that the king would suffer no loss. 3 Then this Daniel distinguished himself above the governors and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king gave thought to setting him over the whole realm.

Prayer is communicating with God. Prayer is simply listening to and talking to God.

Prayer in the beginning. (Genesis 2:15-17; Genesis 3:8-10)

Some of the themes you can discover in the book of Daniel:

- Kingdoms, the anti-Christ spirit throughout the kingdoms of the world, understanding, wisdom, prayer and fasting.
- Keep an excellent spirit through excellent habits.
- How do you get excellent habits?

Due to self-seeking, the systems of the world are vulnerable to an anti- Christ spirit. (Daniel 6:1-9)

Habits win out over knowledge. (Daniel 6:10)

Previous days have determined what we are open towards today.

Change the habit to change the direction of your future.

Established habits sustain you when cross winds blow.

If we have the custom of prayer established before we hit a problem with the area of our possessions, we will have momentum in the right direction to navigate through the potential pitfalls of problems and possessions.

In the end, those who set the traps will be the ones in the trap. (Daniel 6:24)
