Romans 8:1-30 NKJV

Romans 7:24-25 NKJV – O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death? 25 I thank God—through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin.

Romans 7:15 NKJV – For what I am doing, I do not understand. I do what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do.

John 5:24 NKJV – "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.

Romans 8:1-4 – Through the Holy Spirit, God does in us, what Christ has done for us.
