Four summarizing categories:

1. AUTHORITY 2. CULTURAL/ CULTURAL TRADITIONS 3. DISTINCTIVE 4. TRANSCEDENT

- a. Going beyond ordinary limits
- b. Superior, supreme
- c. Going beyond current place and time
- d. Beyond ordinary consciousness

5. The contexts we are in influence our questions. This is because our context influences are attention & attention span.
6. There are questions we have that we are aware of, and there are questions we have that we are unaware of.
7. There are also questions we are aware of but are afraid to ask? (Mark 9:32)
8. Questions can reveal our spiritual depth in a current moment.
9. Questions reveal how far or how close we are from entering the Kingdom of God? (Mk 12:34)
 - Scripture teaches that the kingdom of God is more than a place, more than a position; it is also an experience. An experience of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
 - It is no coincidence that the majority of questions we looked at in the gospel of Mark were related to the two areas Jesus warned to beware of the leaven there.
10. We as humans are vulnerable to prioritize the temporary over the transcendent, the immediate over the eternal.
11. Those who grow to wisely navigate the authority questions, the cultural traditions and trends questions will always be those closest to the kingdom of God.
12. The fruit that they are wise and truly have the correct answers is the manifestation of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.
